As part of the continuous effort to foster inter-disciplinary research collaboration, APSS is hosting another special Research Café to introduce *Dr Zhu Shimin* who will be taking up the position as faculty-based Assistant Professor in APSS in January next year. Dr Zhu received her PhD in Social Work from HKU in 2014 and is currently Post-doctoral Fellow at the Department of Social Work and Social Administration in the same university where she teaches Abnormal Psychology, Counselling Psychology, Family Therapy and Behavioural Modification. Before this she obtained her BSc and M.Ed in Psychology from South China Normal University and lectured in psychology in Guangdong University of Education. In addition, she was also a Fulbright Visiting Scholar at School of Social Work in the University of Michigan in 2013/14. Her current research interests are focused on adolescent mental health and their possible selves, and illicit drug uses.
